- 11. Fishing boundaries Outer Banks allowed.

 Advise tournament control in writing the day prior to departure.
- 12. Any type of boat may be used in the tournament. All participating boats shall have adequate safety equipment on board and must comply with the Port Authority (Safety Equipment on Vessels) Regulations of 1984. All registered anglers chartering boats do so entirely at their own risk.
- 13. All participating boats must have a working VHF radio on board at all times. VHF Channel 28 is the frequency which will be used for all Grand Cayman tournament communications (channel 68 will be used if 28 is down) and in Cayman Brac on 10. Tournament Headquarters radio hours are 7:00am to 6:30pm.
- 14. Fishing hours are 7:00am to 5:00pm.
- 15. It is expressly understood that all those participating in the Tournament do so at their own risk. By registering as an angler in the tournament, the angler holds harmless the Tournament Committee, the organizers, its sponsors and donors and all persons connected directly or indirectly with the operation of the tournament from liability for liable, slander, loss, damage, negligence, harm, injury or death suffered by any participant, entrant, sportfisherman, their companions, boat captains, crew members, family, vessels and equipment which may occur during the tournament.
- 16. By registering as an angler in the tournament, the angler consents that the tournament organizers may use without payment or restrictions any photographs in which he or she appears for any purpose whatsoever, including, but not limited to resale, advertising, commercial or promotional material. The angler further releases the tournament organizers from any injury, loss or damage which may result from the use of said picture(s).
- 17. The entry fee for the Tournament is CI\$300 per team of 4 anglers. Each additional angler is CI\$250. Weigh In Station open 5:00pm to 6:30pm.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. "Spirit of the Tournament" All fishing, conduct, protests and rulings are to be within the intentions and spirit of the tournament. It is intended to be enjoyable, in good fellowship, and for everyone to have a good time.

 Unacceptable conduct (ashore or at sea), unfounded protests, etc., will be strongly considered as grounds for exclusion from the tournament.
- 2. IGFA International Angling Rules will apply. Wire lines are not permitted. Blue Marlin cash prize of more than US\$15,000 will be awarded by IGFA Rules of ½ of 1% of the existing weight.
- 3. All fish entered in this tournament must be caught by registered anglers only and brought to the weigh station by the angler by boat or car on the day the fish was caught.
- 4. Eligible fish in this tournament are Blue Marlin, Wahoo, Yellowfin Tuna and Dolphin.
- 5. Boats with charters crew members cannot be registered anglers.
- 6. Fishing with live bait, as well as the use of kites is permitted.
- 7. There is no limit as to the number of lines which may be fished by each angler or from each boat.
- 8. All boats must check in and out with
 Tournament Headquarters each day. Those
 fishing the outer banks must check out with
 tournament control the night before and return
 to shore the next day (with or without fish to
 weigh).
- 9. In the event of a tie, the prize shall be awarded to the angler reporting landing the winning fish first.
- 10. Notice of protest must be filed in writing to Tournament Control by no later than 10:00am on the day following the alleged offense. All decisions of the Tournament Committee shall be final.
